

Plant Operator – Entry Level

EHRWSD is recruiting a full-time Plant Operator who will work Monday through Friday 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM with occasional overtime and weekend work.

Job Functions:

- Performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled technical and maintenance work in the operation, maintenance and repair of water and wastewater treatment facilities, pump stations, systems and other duties as assigned.

Job Responsibilities:

- Monitors and maintains the performance of all equipment per the required standards of the water, waste treatment and pump station facilities.
- Records statistical data concerning plant operations including performing quality control tests on lab equipment and lab analyses, evaluates procedures and results for accuracy, determines appropriate methods and generates required reports.
- Collects samples and identifies concentrations of chemical, physical or biological characteristics of water and wastewater required in accordance with local, state and federal requirements. Gathers and tests water and wastewater samples for plant efficiency and generate reports as required.
- Promotes cooperative and committed attitudes towards all associates.
- Promotes adherence to District rules and regulations.
- Adhere to all District safety regulations, policies and procedures.

Necessary Knowledge, Skills and Abilities:

- Working knowledge of computers and electronic data processing and proficient mathematical skills.
- Excellent communication skills.
- Excellent writing skills.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Two (2) year degree in biology, environmental science, chemistry or closely related field or:
- Two (2) years of experience in water and wastewater utility or:
- Any equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Ability to obtain an Ohio Operator-In-Training Water designation or Ohio Operator-In-Training Wastewater designation within 24 months.
- Valid Ohio Driver's License.
